Categories that are appropriate for workshop format (75 minutes) or presentation (30 minutes) include:

**Pedagogy:** Demonstration of a teaching strategy utilized to deliver some aspect of the social work curriculum.

**Program Administration:** Discussion of strategies and/or resources being used for some aspect of the administration of social work programs at the undergraduate or graduate level.

**Curriculum Development:** Discussion of a model, framework, or resource(s) that are utilized to deliver a component of the social work curriculum.

**Field Issues:** Discussion of issues relevant to field education and/or presentation of strategies for implementing the field component of the social work curriculum.

Categories that are appropriate for a presentation format (30 minutes) include:

**Research Report:** Original research that has implications for social work education is requested.

**Scholarly Paper:** Scholarly papers describe theoretical discussions and insightful analysis of issues, trends, perspectives, and new models for exploring and understanding the field of social work and/or social work education.

**Practice Reports:** Discussion of an innovation in social work practice that has implications for curriculum development and delivery and/or social work education in general.

**Poster Presentations:** We also welcome proposals for poster presentations. Projects and interests that can be effectively displayed in a visual format aided by appropriate handouts and personal interaction with the presenter are appropriate for this style of presentation. Posters will be displayed throughout the conference with a designated time period for authors to be present to discuss their poster.

1. One copy of a title page that includes:
  - a. Presentation Title
  - b. Presentation format and category
  - c. Name, address and phone numbers of presenter(s) (Include emails)
2. A brief description (2-4 sentences) for the conference brochure
3. A description of the presentation content (maximum of 500 words) **with Bibliography.**
